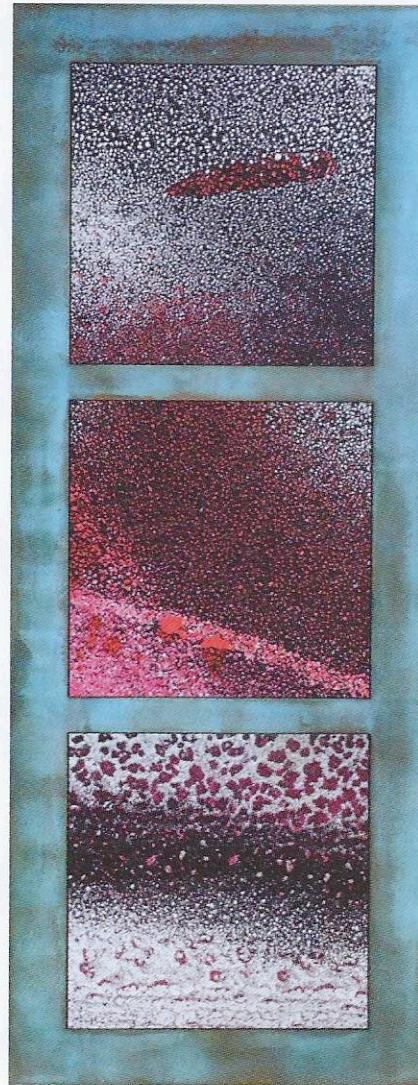

By incorporating hand-finished steel, copper and brass into her abstract works, each piece becomes unique. Form and color are the focus of the photographic compositions, which, under the guiding principle of “the photographer as graphic artist” move in the border area to painting.
